Questions and Answers – Seaport Sams Camping Club

As revised on September 12th, 2010

Q: How do I join the Seaport Sams?

A: Submit an application (available for download from our website at www.seaportsams.org or from the CT Good Sam site located at www.ctgoodsams.org. Membership is open to any individual or family owning or jointly owning a recreational vehicle who are members in good standing of the National Good Sam Club.

Q: How much are the dues?

A: Dues are currently set at \$10.00 per year per rig. There is a one time initiation fee, payable with the first year dues, of \$5.00.

Q: How often do you camp, and where do you go?

A: We have scheduled club campouts from April through October, and often times there are an “Extra” campout at the very end of the season to wrap things up. Our current camping schedule is posted to our website, as are prior year’s schedules going back a few years. Generally speaking we tend to camp reasonably close to home, home being defined as Southeastern CT.

Q: What days do you camp on?

A: Our “Official” camping weekends go from Friday thru Sunday, but many of our members arrive a day early on Thursday.

Q: What are the camping rates?

A: They vary per campground. Generally we receive a discount based on either being Good Sam members or based on the number of rigs attending the campout. Some campgrounds give discounts once you reach 10 rigs, with a higher discount at the 20 rig level.

Q: Where do I go for further information?

A: You can call or Email any of the Chapter Officers. A complete listing is located on the “Chapter Officers” page of the Seaport Sams website at www.seaportsams.org .

Attending a Club campout prior to joining Seaport Sams is not a requirement for membership in the Club but it is encouraged. Make a reservation with our Wagon Master or Club President for a weekend and see how you like camping with us. If you do, we’ll welcome you into our group on the completion of an application and the payment of dues and the first year initiation fee.
